## From The Pastor

### CHAPLET TO ST. MICHAEL

For centuries Catholics have called on St. Michael the Archangel to “defend us in battle” during pandemics and at other stressful times in our lives. The prayer to St. Michael, which was often said after Mass, originated with Pope Leo XIII in 1886. According to historians, Pope Leo had a vision in which the devil did great damage to the Church, and so the Pope composed this prayer to be said after the low Masses at the time. Another way to call upon St. Michael to protect us is to pray the “*Chaplet of St. Michael*,” given to us by Carmelite nun, Antonia d’Astonaco. Pope Pius IX approved it in 1851. The Chaplet of Saint Michael begins with an Act of Contrition followed by 9 “salutations” each recognizing the choirs of angels. The salutations are followed by an Our Father and three Hail Marys. Finally, four Our Fathers are prayed to honor Saints Michael, Gabriel, Raphael and our Guardian Angel. A prayer to St. Michael concludes the chaplet. The nine salutations beautifully invoke the choirs of angels:

1. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Seraphim, may the Lord make us worthy to burn with the fire of perfect charity. Amen.
2. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Cherubim, may the Lord grant us the grace to leave the ways of sin and run in the paths of Christian perfection. Amen.
3. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Thrones, may the Lord infuse into our hearts a true and sincere spirit of humility. Amen.
4. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Dominions, may the Lord give us grace to govern our senses and overcome any unruly passions. Amen.
5. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Virtues, may the Lord preserve us from evil and falling into temptation. Amen.
6. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Powers, may the Lord protect our souls against the snares and temptations of the devil. Amen.
7. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Principalities, may God fill our souls with a true spirit of obedience. Amen.
8. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Archangels, may the Lord give us perseverance in faith and in all good works in order that we may attain the glory of Heaven. Amen.
9. By the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Angels, may the Lord grant us to be protected by them in this mortal life and conducted in the life to come to Heaven. Amen.

Concluding prayers: O glorious prince St. Michael, chief and commander of the heavenly hosts, guardian of souls, vanquisher of rebel spirits, servant in the house of the Divine King and our admirable conductor, you who shine with excellence and superhuman virtue deliver us from all evil, who turn to you with confidence and enable us by your gracious protection to serve God more and more faithfully every day.

Pray for us, O glorious St. Michael, Prince of the Church of Jesus Christ, that we may be made worthy of His promises.

Almighty and Everlasting God, Who, by a prodigy of goodness and a merciful desire for the salvation of all men, has appointed the most glorious Archangel St. Michael Prince of Your Church, make us worthy, we ask You, to be delivered from all our enemies, that none of them may harass us at the hour of death, but that we may be conducted by him into Your Presence. This we ask through the merits of Jesus Christ Our Lord. Amen.

(Pray the chaplet anytime. Pray it on September 29, the feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Rafael. It can be a shield against “the wickedness of the devil” especially during difficult times.)

## Have you received your Economic Impact Payment?

An estimated 12 million people haven't yet accessed their \$1,200 stimulus payment, because they simply don't know there are funds available or they need a little help taking steps on the IRS' website. Mostly these are people whose income falls below requirements and do not regularly file taxes. They tend to be Medicaid and/or SNAP recipients, struggling with homelessness, disconnected from financial institutions, disconnected from the internet. Please help spread the word they can apply for their payment at <https://www.irs.gov/coronavirus/get-my-payment> **Deadline to file is October 15, 2020.**

### Fraud Alert re: SNAP

The USDA issued a fraud alert after receiving people getting text messages that appear to be from SNAP. The text might say you were chosen to receive food stamps or SNAP. If you do not know if a request for information about SNAP is real or not, contact your local SNAP office at 631-854-6630. Never share personal information such as your social security number, bank information, or SNAP electronic transfer card or PIN number, with individuals that you do not know. Do not reply, just delete.

Last day to apply in-person: November 2

Postmark absentee ballots by November 2; board of elections must receive by November 10.
